

## **Brief overview of health and risk factors in the city of Hull**

- Average life expectancy at birth in Hull is 3.1 years lower for men (75.2 years) and 2.3 years lower for women (80.0 years) compared to England (2007-2009).
- Under 75 standardised mortality ratio for CHD and cancer are high for men (146, 131) and women (174, 129) (2007-2009).
- 19 wards in Hull are in the most deprived 40% nationally with 17 in the bottom 20% (Index of Multiple Deprivation, 2010).
- The prevalence of smoking in Hull is 34% (men) and 33% (women) compared to 22% & 20% for England (all 2009).
